Hi James,

There are 3 different fasteners for the chrome beading on the fascia.

First there are 7 - #4x1/2" Round Head WS equally spaced on the bottom.
These are chrome plated.
Next there are 3- #4x1/2" Flat Head WS on the top. 1 centered and 1 on each end. These are countersunk, which will allow the dash an easy removal from the fascia at a later date and will not bind on the dash piping.
Finally, there are 10 #18 x 1/2" escutcheon pins on the top. There are 5 on each side equally spaced between the center and end screw mentioned above.

Hello Fellow Listers,

A friend of mine who is (against all the odds) restoring a TC in

Kenya has asked me about the method of fixing the chrome beading around the dash.

The Factory Specification Book refers to "Fascia Board Moulding" and "Woodscrew Round Head 1/2" x No. 4 Brass Chrome Plated" (7 off). This entry is applicable to the bottom of the dash and I am able to validate this from taking one of these screws out of my car.

There is also an entry "Escutcheon pins 1/2" x 18 S.W.G." (10 off). These must be for along the top of the dash, but I am unable to validate as I don't want to undo what's already there.

Can anybody who has recently done work in this area validate this, please?
